

The Scolytidae of the Logan Canyon Area In Utah and Their Host Plants

A study of the bark beetles of the Logan Canyon area of northern Utah resulted in the rediscovery of several virtually unknown Scolytidae and in finding some host relationships which were previously unknown. All collections were made by the author during the years 1946 to 1949. The following list gives the name and the host plant of the Scolytidae collected during this study.
